Dear Parents,

Thank you very much for paying any monies owed at the beginning of the year. Getting this sorted means that teachers have more time to devote to teaching and learning which should be our main focus in the school. If you have any bills outstanding please settle these immediately. Thank you.

During our playground supervision we have noticed that occasionally a parent or relation will lean in over the school wall to talk to a child or hand them their lunch. While this is typically a happy and safe moment we are concerned that there is the (thankfully small) possibility that such an encounter might not be so well meaning. So for the safety of all our pupils we remind you to please contact Kathleen or one of the teachers on supervision if you wish to speak to a child during the day. We trust you will understand that this small inconvenience for you is in the best interests of the children. Thank you for your cooperation.

In partnership with the Parents Association we have expanded our range of PE Activities this year that will involve some outdoor and indoor activities as well as gymnastics. All classes will be taking part this year. There will be eight sessions between now and Christmas and eight more between Christmas and Easter. The sessions will begin next Monday (24<sup>th</sup>). To help to cover the cost the Parents Association is asking for a contribution of €1 per pupil per day and we would prefer if you could pay in one installment of €8 for this term if at all possible to your child's teacher. Thank you.
